Fishing Derby Rules and Regulations:

Before the Event:

1. Registration for the event will start on May 22 and continue until all of the participant slots are filled. Those wishing to participate may find the registration form at www.summerfieldnc.gov and return completed form to town hall, fax to 336-643-8654, or email to cgore@summerfieldnc.gov.
2. Space is limited to 50 participants, ages six through twelve. A waiting list will be used after 50 participants have been registered.
3. Those who register and find they will not be able to attend the event should contact town hall prior to the event. This process will allow the fishing derby team time to contact other children who were placed on a waiting list.
4. The NC Wildlife Resources Commission Fishing For Fun will provide rods and reels for participants needing one. *If you do not have a rod and reel, please specify under other comments on the registration form.*

Day of the Event:

5. Participants must check in prior to fishing on derby day.
6. Parents and guardians understand that all youth participants must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
7. Children can bring their own rod and reel and hooks. A goodie bag and t-shirt will be provided to all participants.
8. Only one rod may be used per participant.
9. Worms will be provided for participants.
10. Designated fishing areas will be marked by staked flags. All fishing must be conducted within the flagged boundaries.
11. Fish should be brought to the volunteer table for measuring immediately after being caught.
12. Should any unsafe or unsportsmanlike conduct be observed, the participant may be asked to leave the fishing area.
13. We will recognize participants for the largest fish and most fish caught.
14. A whistle will sound to end the fishing time. Any fish caught after the whistle will not be included in the recognition. All participants will be asked to gather for the closing announcements directly after the whistle sounds. Medals will be handed out at this time.
15. Parents, guardians, and participants understand that any and all decisions made by the fishing derby team will be considered final in all matters of this event.
