



**NCDOT request to repeal municipal speed zones**

**STAFF COMMENTS / RECOMMENDATION:**

NCDOT is requesting that the Town concur with the State recommendation to repeal State ordinances that established speed zones on US-220 per the attached information. The repealed ordinances will be replaced with ordinances suitable for access-controlled highways which will not require concurring municipal ordinances.

This matter is a housekeeping item requested by DOT as part of their effort to have I-73 designated as eligible for federal interstate maintenance funding. This action will not result in changes to the current speed limits. The speed limit on US-220 through Summerfield will remain 50-mph, as currently signed. In addition, the speed limit on US-220 north of Winfree Road will remain 60-mph, as currently signed.

To Whom It May Concern:

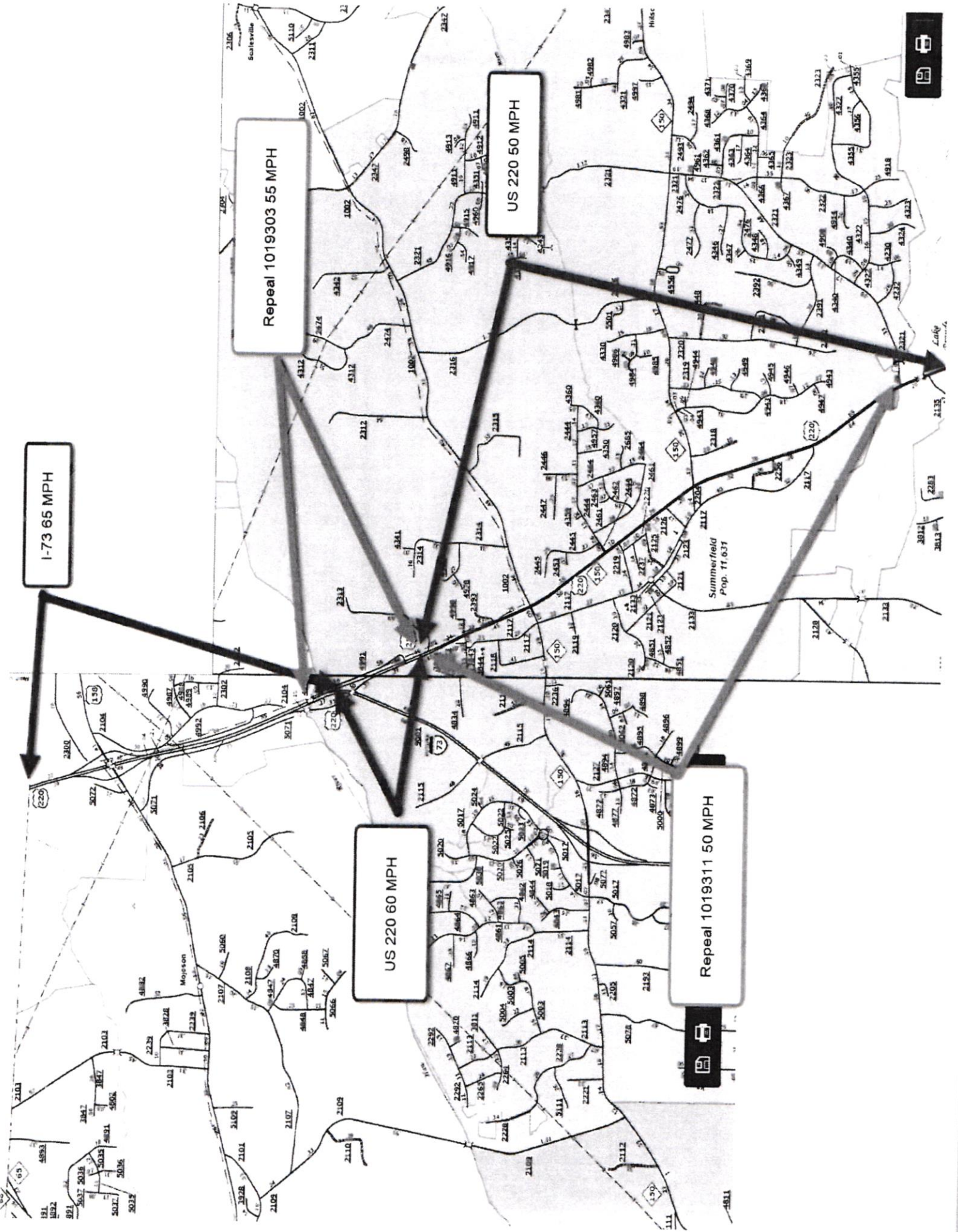
As you are aware, recent improvements to US 220 and the construction of I-73 is complete in your area. These improvements included upgrading access control of US 220 within and beyond the Town of Summerfield. Please find the enclosed municipal speed zones on US 220 enacted in 2001 which were impacted by the recently completed construction. These ordinances have been identified for repeal due to overlaps with controlled access highways I-73 and US 220 and will be replaced with ordinances suitable for access-controlled highways which will not require concurring municipal ordinances.
