Dear Neighbor:

The Transco Pipeline Main Line B Replacement that was scheduled for February of this year and then cancelled due to changing guidelines from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, known as PHMSA, has now been determined to be partially required under the PHMSA changes.

The goal of the Main Line B Replacement is to return the line to its full operating pressure; it has been at reduced capacity for the past several years. The changes put in place by PHMSA earlier in the year negated the need for the Main Line B work, confirming the effectiveness of the pipeline integrity programs Williams currently has in place. However, further review of the new PHMSA guidelines related to house count has placed a portion of the maintenance work back on the schedule.

One of the changing PHMSA requirements pertains to the relationship of the pipe wall thickness, its operating pressure, and the house count adjacent to the location of the pipe. This amended "clustering methodology" has prompted Williams to reschedule a portion of the original replacement work. The reduced footprint will include a segment of approximately 4,500 feet from Whitaker Drive to the Haw River; and a segment of approximately 1,500 feet from Flatrock Road to north of the second crossing of Millrun Road. This represents about half of the original proposed maintenance in those two areas.

This work will utilize the same workspace as shown in the aerial drawings previously provided in the letter dated December 15, 2025. A copy of the aerial drawing related to your property is included with this letter.

Main Line B is located between Main Line A and C. The existing Main Line B will be excavated, cut into sections, and removed. The new line will be placed in the original Main Line B ditch.

The project is scheduled to begin on June 10th. You may see pipeline personnel visiting the Transco right of way between now and the start date to gather information in preparation for this work. A survey crew will begin flagging the workspace and marking the Transco pipelines prior to June 10th. Main Line B is scheduled to be back in service on, or about, August 28th.

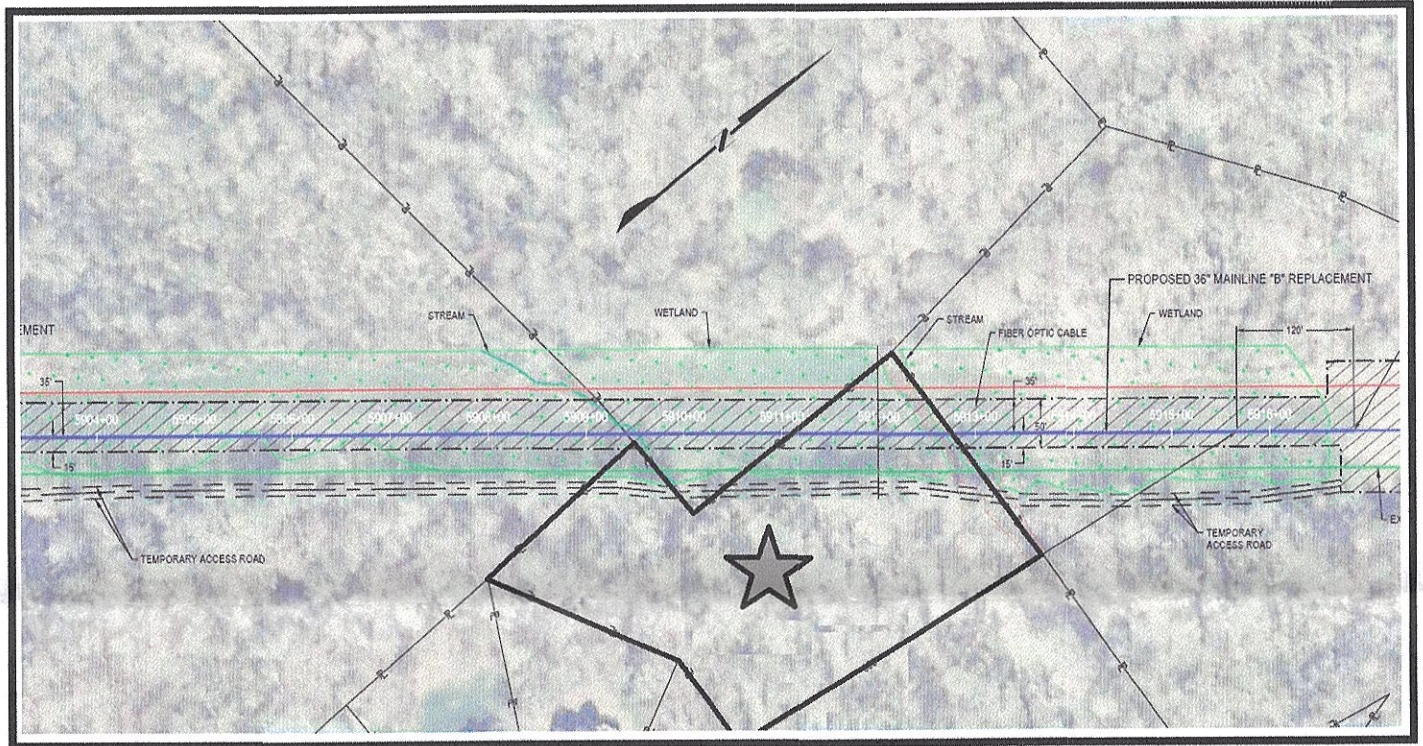
